

RA 9155 (August 2001) GOVERNANCE OF BASIC EDUCATION ACT (DECS to DepEd) Chapter 2: Transfer of Cultural Agencies to NCCA Cognizant of the need to accelerate the process of integrating culture in the basic education curriculum and mainstreaming it in national development plans, the NCCA Board of Commissioners, in its September 2001 meeting, resolved that a Philippine Cultural Education Plan (PCEP) be formulated and operationalized PCEP was launched as comprehensive Commission flagship program. \*February 23, Moved to jumpstart the PCEP and constitute TWG headed by Comm. Jardin as Chair and establish an Institute.

\*August 9, Mr. Bong Antonio was asked by Comm. Hardin to present the PCEP Program Component's Phase 1: Sangunian and Gabay sa Pagtuturo ng Kulturang Filipino.

\*October 12, Approved mobilization fund for PCEP Implementation.



# BOC MEETING

\*NCCA Board of Commissioners created the PCEP TASKFORCE (same with 2002 people) in March 15, and approved the P500,000 mobilization fund.

\*April 10, Comm Jardin called attention of the body for the institutionalization of PCEP – an Institutional Arrangement, approval of ADHOC, mobilization fund, terms of reference and the functions of the Program Director and a Program Associate.



2007

\*May 10, (BR # 2007-104) recognizing Philippine Cultural Education Plan <u>as the Philippine Cultural</u> <u>Education PROGRAM</u> – Comm. de Leon sought to clarify whether the Philippine Cultural education Plan would be adopted as a Program. Mr. Corpuz clarifies that the adoption of the PCEP as a program rather than a plan has been suggested by Comm. Jardin, and discussed during an AdHoc Meeting. The Board Secretary inquired if there was a motion for the Commission to adopt the PCEP as a <u>Program</u>. Upon motion made by Comm. Jardin and duly seconded by Comm. De Leon, the majority of the Commissioners approved and confirmed BR# 2007-104. 2.0 PLAN 2008 I. CRUZ (Chair Vilma Labrador / ED Cecile Guidote \*On August 1, the NCCA Board appointed former NCCA Vice-Chair and former DepEd Undersecretary Dr. Isagani R. Cruz as PCEP Director and Dr. Antonio Hila as PCEP Program Associate, with three (3) deliverables by January 31, 2009: 1. A long-term strategic work plan for the implementation of PCEP; 2. Initiation of the establishment of an educational consortium to undertake implementation of various component projects of PCEP;

\*March 28, BOC Meeting on the issues of Cultural Diplomacy Strategic Plan – BOC recommended to assist **DFA in the training** and education of cultural officers for Philippine arts and culture by developing a Cultural Education Program.
